Net takes place every Wednesday at noon on the DFMA TV Hill 2m repeater, 145.450(-) PL82.5.

5 Minute Warning

(11:55 AM) This is {your call}. The Triangle Mutual Aid Net will begin in 5 minutes.

The repeater frequency you are hearing is 145.450. It has a negative offset and a tone of 82.5.

Again, the net begins in about 5 minutes. Please make any urgent calls now

Net Introduction

(12:00 PM) Calling the Triangle Mutual Aid Net. Calling the Triangle Mutual Aid Net.

This is {name, phonetic call} serving as Net Control.

This net meets Wednesdays at noon on the 145.450 DFMA repeater with a tone of 82.5. The purpose of this net is to connect mutual aid activities around the Triangle with amateur radio, and to build radio operating skills for emergencies.

The order of business is: Check Ins, Announcements and then the Rag Chew.

This is a directed net, using the same procedure that would apply in an emergency.

Members, guests, and visitors are all welcome to participate in this net. When checking in, say your phonetic call sign slowly, pause and listen briefly to avoid doubling, then give your name and location. If you do not wish to participate in the rag-chew portion, indicate with "In and Out" when you check in.

Check-Ins

Any stations with emergency, priority or time-value traffic, call net control, {your call}, now. (Deal with any emergency traffic now)

Any mobile or portable stations who may move out of range, call net control, {your call}, now. (For each station, log them, acknowledge them, and get any brief comment they have.)

Check-in will be by call sign suffix. Stations with suffixes Alpha through November, call now. (For each check-in, log and acknowledge it, and ask for the next check-in.)

Stations with suffixes Oscar through Zulu, call now. (For each check-in, log and acknowledge it, and ask for the next check-in.)

Last call for check-ins. Suffixes Alpha through Zulu, call now. (For each check-in, log and acknowledge it, and ask for the next check-in.)

Announcements

We will now move on to the announcements portion of the net.

Stations with Triangle Mutual Aid announcements, bulletins or business, call net control {your call} now.

(Log and acknowledge each calling station. After each, ask for the next.)

(Call each station with an announcement and let them announce it.)

Rag Chew

We will now move on to the Rag Chew portion. (Suggest a topic here.)

(Call first half of check-in stations in order one at a time.)

(Ask for any additional check ins and add to the list.)

(Call second half of check-in stations in order one at a time.)

Conclusion

This concludes this week's Triangle Mutual Aid Net. Join us again next Wednesday at noon, here on the WR4AGC 145.450 repeater, negative offset, with a tone of 82.5. Thanks to the DFMA for the use of the repeater.

Next week's net control is {other call sign}.

Thanks to all who checked in or just listened to today's net. This is {your call sign} returning the repeater to regular amateur use.
